4th Thurgau Experimental Economics Meeting (theem) Reference-dependent preferences

April 17-19, 2013 in Kreuzlingen (CH)

Organized by the Thurgau Institute of Economics at the University of Konstanz

There is no doubt that reference points are relevant in human decision making. People do not like having less than others and they dislike losses in comparison to the status quo. However, there is no clear evidence about how reference points are formed. Past experience and social environments often seem to shape a person's reference point; recent work furthermore emphasizes the importance of expectations as a determinant. This conference intends to shed light on the formation of reference points. We invite contributions discussing reference-dependent preferences, in particular those which discuss the formation of reference points and how they enter preferences. We welcome experimental, theoretical, and empirical research from economics, psychology, and other related disciplines.

Keynote speakers at the conference are Botond Kőszegi and Lorenz Götte.
