Post-Doctoral Position in Experimental and Behavioral Economics

(Full Time/ TV-L E13 or A13)

The Chair of Economic Theory at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg offers a Post-Doctoral Position as of August 1, 2014 (or later).

The Chair focuses on research in experimental and behavioral economics as well as market design. Prof. Grimm is director of the Laboratory for Experimental Research Nuremberg (LERN) and coordinates various research projects in the area of energy market design as well as in the emerging fields project "Taxation, Social Norms, and Compliance: Lessons for Institution Design" at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg. Post-doctoral researchers are encouraged to work in the abovementioned fields. We offer intensive supervision within a large and interactive team, challenging research projects, and a close contact to practitioners in various fields.

Applicants should have completed a PhD degree in economics or a related field (or should be close to completion). The ideal candidate has a fundamental knowledge in microeconomics (especially applied game theory and industrial economics), experience in experimental or empirical research and a strong quantitative background. Candidates should have published in internationally recognized journals or should have several research papers with high potential. Fluent English skills are required, German would be an asset.

Fields of responsibility may include participation in ongoing research and teaching, as well as support in the establishment of one of the research areas "Taxation, Social Norms, and Compliance: Lessons for Institution Design" or Energy Market Design within "Energie Campus Nürnberg" (EnCN) at FAU Erlangen-Nuremberg.

Salary corresponds to the German pay scale and depends on qualification (TV-L E13 or A 13). Women are strongly encouraged to apply. Severely disabled applicants will be preferred when equally qualified.
